CONTEST RULES

- 1. THA poster contest is limited to 2017 graduating seniors in Texas public, private, charter and home schools.
- 2. NO copyright material may appear on the poster. NO BRAND names or likenesses of any products allowed (automatic disqualification).
- 3. Poster designs must be original, and may be computer or electronically generated, hand-drawn or photographed.
- 4. Size: Any size between 8.5x11 inches and up to 14x18 inches.
- 5. Deadline: All entries must be postmarked no later than: Friday, May 5, 2017, 11:59 pm.
- 6. Required: Submitted artwork must have clearly printed on the back: (1) student's name and contact information (2) high school name (3) high school mailing address, email address & phone number (Need to be able to contact school personnel.)
- 7. The scholarship winners will be determined by a vote of each Texas Legislative office. All decisions are within the discretion of THA and those decisions are final.
- 8. All entries become the property of THA for use at its discretion and will not be returned. By sending in a poster design, students, and their parents or legal guardians, agree THA may use, without compensation, artwork and the winner's name, age, hometown, school name and likeness for promotional purposes in THA's 2017 campaign against underage drinking in Texas.
- 9. THA shall make the scholarships payable to the accredited college, university or institution of higher learning designated by the winners, in care of the individual winner for use during the 2017-18 school year. The scholarship is not assignable or transferable.
